## Christ Is the Passover Lamb Hebrews 11:27-29

## 1. Moses' decision was confident.

By faith he left Egypt, not being afraid of the anger of the king, for he endured as seeing him who is invisible. **Hebrews 11:27 (ESV)** 

Then Pharaoh called Moses and Aaron and said, "Go, sacrifice to your God within the land." **Exodus 8:25 (English Standard Version)** 

So Pharaoh said, "I will let you go to sacrifice to the LORD your God in the wilderness; only you must not go very far away. Plead for me." **Exodus 8:28 (English Standard Version)** 

But not a dog shall growl against any of the people of Israel, either man or beast, that you may know that the LORD makes a distinction between Egypt and Israel.' **Exodus 11:7 (ESV)** 

So, Moses and Aaron were brought back to Pharaoh. "All right," he told them, "go and worship the LORD your God. But who exactly will be going with you?" <sup>9</sup> Moses replied, "We will all go—young and old, our sons and daughters, and our flocks and herds. We must all join together in celebrating a festival to the LORD." <sup>10</sup> Pharaoh retorted, "The LORD will certainly need to be with you if I let you take your little ones! I can see through your evil plan. <sup>11</sup> Never! Only the men may go and worship the LORD, since that is what you requested." And Pharaoh threw them out of the palace. Exodus 10:8-11 (New Living Translation)

And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household." Acts 16:31 (English Standard Version)

Then Pharaoh called Moses and said, "Go, serve the LORD; your little ones also may go with you; only let your flocks and your herds remain behind." **Exodus 10:24 (English Standard Version)** 

Our livestock also must go with us; not a hoof shall be left behind, for we must take of them to serve the LORD our God, and we do not know with what we must serve the LORD until we arrive there." Exodus 10:26 (English Standard Version)

## 2. God's deliverance.

By faith he left Egypt, not being afraid of the anger of the king, for he endured as seeing him who is invisible. <sup>28</sup> By faith he kept the Passover and sprinkled the blood, so that the Destroyer of the firstborn might not touch them. <sup>29</sup> By faith the people crossed the Red Sea as on dry land, but the Egyptians, when they attempted to do the same, were drowned. **Hebrews 11:27-29 (ESV)** 

The LORD said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, <sup>2</sup> "This month shall be for you the beginning of months. It shall be the first month of the year for you. <sup>3</sup> Tell all the congregation of

Israel that on the tenth day of this month every man shall take a lamb according to their fathers' houses, a lamb for a household... <sup>5</sup> Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats, <sup>6</sup> and you shall keep it until the fourteenth day of this month, when the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill their lambs at twilight. <sup>7</sup> "Then they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses in which they eat it. <sup>8</sup> They shall eat the flesh that night, roasted on the fire; with unleavened bread and bitter herbs they shall eat it. **Exodus 12:1-3; 5-8 (ESV)** 

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! John 1:29 (English Standard Version)

For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, <sup>24</sup> and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." <sup>25</sup> In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." **1 Corinthians 11:23-25 (ESV)** 

Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, <sup>12</sup> saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!" <sup>13</sup> And I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying, "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!" **Revelation 5:11-13 (ESV)**
